- Monitoring individual animal health and enrichment
- Accurate records management including data collection and entry
- Ensure infection control procedures are followed
- Laundry duties
- Providing customer service to the public
- Assisting with adoptions and inquires
- Compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act

- Certificate as Animal Care Attendant or good working knowledge of animal welfare practices
- Completion of high school
- Able to lift 50 pounds
- Must be self motivated with a high energy level
